The villas are designed with large windows to make the most of the beautiful views of the green surroundings. As standard, they are equipped with ducted air conditioning, double glazing, shutters and a fully equipped kitchen, in addition to a separate laundry room for added convenience. Each plot is fenced for maximum privacy and, depending on size, offers the possibility of parking on site. The garden is neatly finished with artificial grass, and there is a pre-installation for charging electric cars. Ask about private pool options.

The average construction time of the villas is 18 to 24 months. Prices of the 4-bedroom villas start at 613,000 euros.
